Please supply the items listed below. We have requested, in some cases, a particular brand, as our experiences have shown many brands do not stand up and therefore become a waste of your money. Students in our grade 1 and 2 classes will share materials to ensure that everyone has what they need in a timely manner.

For families experiencing financial hardship, Tools for Schools backpacks and supplies can be provided. Please contact the office if you require this assistance.

Please **do not** label the following items:

- 20 Staedtler pencils
- 4 Staedtler white erasers
- 4 fine black sharpies
- 4 ultra-fine black sharpies
- 4 large glue sticks (Please do not send Dollar Store glue sticks - they just dry out)
- 5 Hilroy Exercise Books – 72 pages, ½ plain, ½ interlined (Green)
- 1 old clean sock (for using as eraser for whiteboard)
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
- 1 pair of child's scissors, pointed tip
- 24 or more Crayola wax crayons (Grade 1 only)
- 1 3-ring binder with a a one-inch spine
- 1 pkg 24 Staedtler or Crayola Pencil Crayons (Grade 2 only)

Please **label** the following items:

- 1 set of over the ear headphones in a Ziploc bag
- 1 pair of running shoes for indoor use only (please no laces unless students can tie them on their own)

To purchase on your own or **from the school**:

- Art Journals – Beginning in Grade 1, students will require a 9" x 12" hard cover artist sketch book (art journal) that will continue with them throughout their journey at Mount Royal school. They can be purchased from the school for \$8.00
- Agendas –All students are expected to keep a daily agenda of upcoming events or class information. You may purchase one from the office for \$9.00
